Option 1: City Bus

Take the northbound #72 Swartz Bay or #70x Swartz Bay Express from the corner of Douglas and Pandora to the McTavish Exchange (approx. 45 minutes)







or: the YYJ Airport Shuttle stops in front of the Ministry of Health building across the street








