Getting There by Car

Mount Washington is located 244 kilometers north of Victoria near Courtenay.

Take the Douglas Street/Trans-Canada Highway/BC-1 North, then merge onto Highway 19(Nanaimo Pkwy) via the ramp to Parksville/Campbell River.

Continue to follow Highway 19 north to Exit 130 (Dove Creek Rd & Strathcona Parkway).

Turn left at the lights (Exit #130) and follow Strathcona Parkway up the mountain for 18 km's.

NOTE: The road is paved but Strathcona Parkway requires good winter tires OR that you carry chains with you.
