# Parking

There are many places to park during your stay in Victoria. Here are some suggestions:

### Ocean Island's Parking Lot

We have limited parking available in the lot behind our building at a rate of \$15/day (from after 3pm until 1pm the following day). Parking cannot be reserved in advance. Please only park on the designated parking spots for Ocean Island Inn to avoid towing. See our Front Desk for details.

Ocean Island is not responsible for any fined, towed or damaged vehicles. PLEASE DON'T LEAVE ANY VALUABLES IN YOUR CAR.

#### Johnson St Parkade

The nearest parkade to Ocean island Inn is the Johnson St. parkade. Located a block away at 750 Johnson St. This is a four story city parkade. First hour is free, or \$2 every additional hour. \$16 per day (24 hours). Free overnight parking (6pm - 8am), Sundays and holidays.

## The City of Victoria Parkades There are five parkades downtown:

- •Bastion Square Parkade 500 Block of Yates St.
- •Broughton St Parkade 700 Block of Broughton St.
- •Centennial Parkade 600 Block of Fisgard St.
- •Johnson St Parkade 700 Johnson St.
- •View St. Parkade 700 Block of View St.

The first hour of parking is always free in any five of these parkades, as well as in the evenings between the hours 6 p.m. and 8 a.m. and on Sundays and holidays. Rates for these parkades are \$2/hr, or have a \$16/h day rate (\$17.50/h for Bastion Square due to demand).

### Free Parking and Street Parking

Starting May 1st, parking is free at all metered parking spaces on the streets from 6pm - 9am and all day on Stat. Holidays. Otherwise you will need to feed the meter 25 cents fo every 10 minutes. Be vigilant though; Victoria's parking attendants are as stealthy and lethal as ninjas!

There are some 1-2 hour free parking zones on the outskirts of the downtown core. Check out the area near Chinatown (north of Fisgard St. and west of Government St.) or east of Quadra St. and south of Fort St. There are also some 3 hour free parking zones in Beacon Hill Park.

There are a few places near town you can park free all-day although these are usually a bit of a walk away. Check out Tyee Rd.--across the Johnson St. bridge and turn right at the first major intersection; or in the area east of Cook St.

### How to Use a Pay Station

Using a pay station is easy:


- 1. Park and note your space number.
- 2. At a pay station **in your parking zone**, enter your space number.
- 3. Choose your method of payment (coin, credit card or the City's Parking Card).
- 4. Purchase the time you require
- 5. Print and collect your receipt there's no need to return to your vehicle.


A pay station's main screen provides prompts throughout the transaction. Your receipt includes your parking space number and the date and time of expiry.
