

# How to Get to Thetis Lake Park

## By Public Transit:

Total Travelling time: Approx. 40 minutes

Cost: \$2.50 one way (exact change required)

1. Take the #50 Langford from the corner of Douglas at Pandora to the Old Island Highway at Six Mile Road (ask the driver for the nearest stop). Travelling time: Approx. 25 minutes.
  2. Six Mile Road will be just past the gas station and to your right. Follow that road for approximately 1 kilometre by foot and you're at the main entrance. Travelling time: Approx. 15 minutes

## By Car:

Total Travelling time: Approx. 20 minutes

From the hostel go down Pandora and turn right on Douglas. Douglas will turn into Highway #1 North, follow this for roughly 10 minutes (varies with traffic). Take Exit 10 to the Colwood / View Royal exit. You're now on the Old Island Highway. At the second set of lights, by the gas station & pub, is Six Mile Road. Turn right here and follow it until you reach the park.

Between May and September there is a day-use parking fee. Otherwise it is free. Most dispensers accept coins and credit cards.
